

What are we proposing?

One Horton Heath - Access & Circulation



- Vehicle Movements
- Pedestrian and Cycle Routes
 - Local Access / Existing Access to Foxholes Farm Cottage
- Public Right of Way
 - Bus Stops on Foxwood Road

- The newly completed 'Avenue' link road will provide the principal means of access to Hedge End and Fair Oak.
- Parking provisions have been carefully planned to balance the future needs of residents with the need to promote long term sustainable travel objectives.
- A high quality walking and cycling greenway will run east-west linking The Avenue and the Local Centre through the heart of The Folds.
- Safe and direct footpaths and cycleways will follow key roads and provide direct routes.
- Fir Tree Lane reclassified as a new bridleway for pedestrians and cyclists.
- New links will connect into the improved public rights of way.
- New **bus stops** along the main internal road will support sustainable travel and reduce reliance on cars.
- **Highways contributions** agreed as part of OPA to mitigate the development impacts at key junctions.
